Progress on ALIADA development

ALIADA 2nd release is now ready for deployment

As scheduled, the second prototype of ALIADA was finished by the end of April and it's ready for deployment. Artium Basque Museum of Contemporary Art Vitoria-Gasteiz and the Museum of Fine Arts Budapest will upgrade their installations of ALIADA to the new release. This release includes the Publication module, the last step in the process after the conversion to RDF and the linking to other datasets. As expected, ALIADA is integrated in the library and museum management systems currently used by the museums in the Consortium.
